



Bike Valet FAQs

What is bike valet?

Bike valet is like coat check for bicycles. Bike valets make parking easy and stress free for attendees and ensure bikes stay safe throughout the event.

How does bike valet work?

Head to the valet station when you arrive. When checking in your bike, you'll receive a claim ticket for later. DBC volunteers will securely park your bike in a monitored area. When you're ready to leave, you return your claim ticket, and your bike is returned to you.

Is it safe?

Yes, it is safe! The valet area is fenced off and monitored at all times by trained volunteers.

What all can I check at the bike valet?

Right now, we can take traditional and electric bicycles, cargo bikes, personal scooters, and skateboards. We are unable to check strollers, bags, or other personal items.

Why are we adding this to the Katy 5K?

Driving and parking a vehicle can be challenging for this event. Leave your car at home or save on rideshare and arrive stress free on your bike.

How much does the bike valet cost?
